



TotalEnergies has climate at the heart of its strategy



TotalEnergies has adopted a strategy where it continues to supply the energy the world requires today, while accelerating the transition toward low-carbon energy in a responsible and sustainable way. The Company is taking action to reinvent energy and achieve carbon neutrality by 2050, together with

- society, by:
 Reducing the emissions generated by its operated facilities, and
- Investing in low-carbon energies and supporting its customers to change their habits.



Furthermore, the Company has acted in the last quarter by:

- Joining forces with SSE to create Source, a new major player in EV charging in the UK & Ireland.
- Selling its interests in West of Shetland gas fields.
- Organising volunteer days to support the Queen Elizabeth Foundation for Disabled People with developing greener outdoor spaces.
- Supporting Willowtown Community Primary School, with their "Big Bocs Bwyd" initiative. This project aims to serve families and the wider community. The "Big Bocs Bwyd" is a converted shipping container that functions as a small community shop with a mission to reduce food poverty and minimize food waste.
- Offering free trials of kWIQly to 4 customers which includes workshops and support for 3-months.
- Offering free bronze AMR to all CCS customers to help monitor usage and accuracy of billing of which 15% of sites currently use, with plans throughout the year to increase this.
