ELIGIBILITY FOR SELECTION OF QUALITY CONTROL AND NON-DESTRUCTIVE TESTING:

- Eligible Ugandans aged 18 years and above at the time of application (Applicants from Nwoya, Buliisa, Masindi, Pakwach, Hoima, and Kikuube districts shall be given first priority).
- National Technical Certificate in Metal Fabrication and Mechanical Engineering OR at least 3 years' welding practice/experience in the industry.
- Having an international welder certificate would be an added advantage.
- Should have at least trained in any of the welding disciplines at a university or Vocational Training Institute.
- Applicants are required to have basic English and calculation skills.
- Female candidates are strongly encouraged to apply.

REQUIREMENTS

- Application letter.
- Original/Certified copies of relevant certificates (where applicable).
- LC1 letter stating the district of origin and town of residence. Recommendation from previous/current employer.
- A copy of a National ID.
- Two (2) clear colored passport size photographs
