What have you learnt about the Oil and Gas sector while working with TotalEnergies EP Ug?

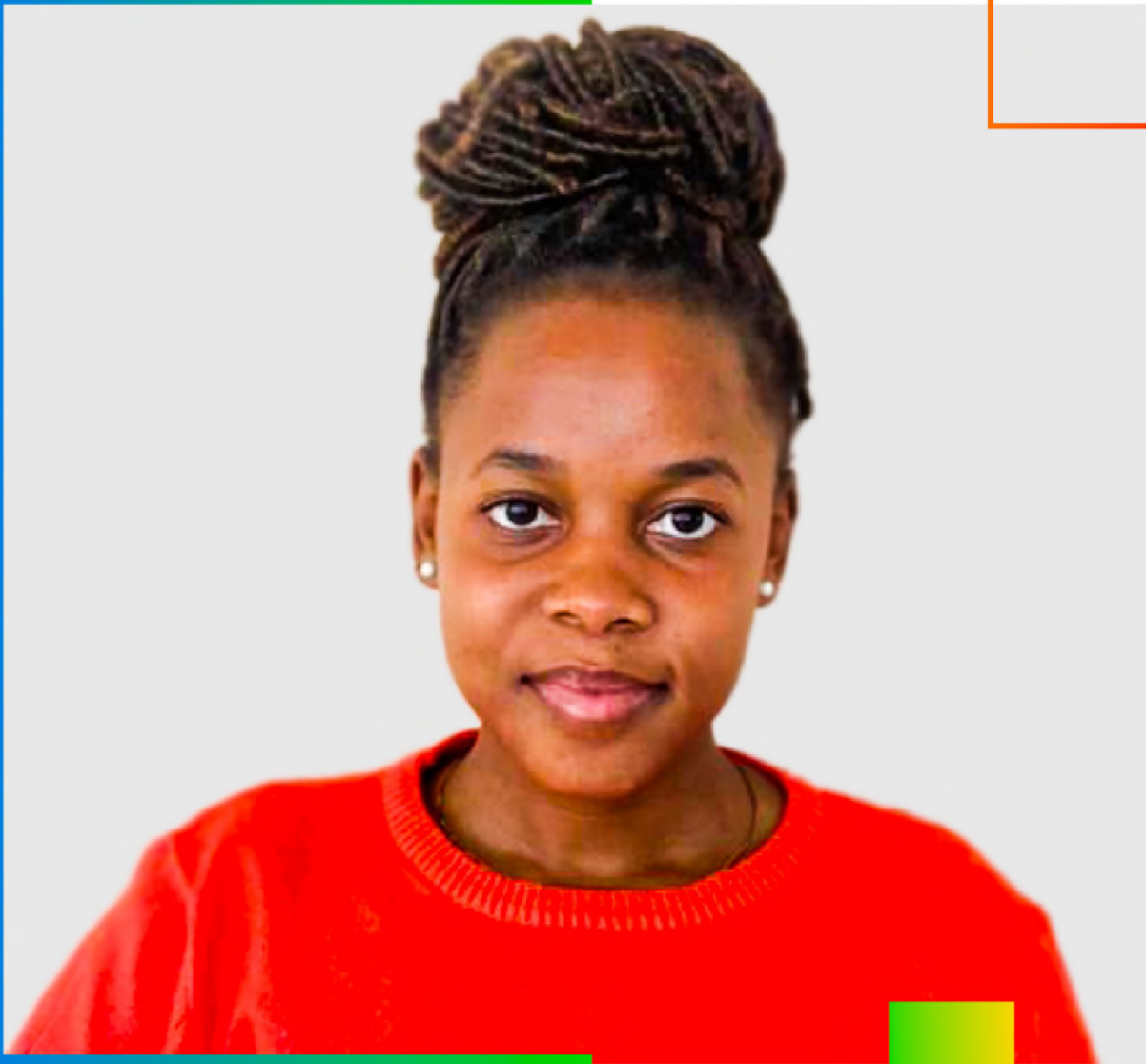
