


TotalEnergies Marketing Lebanon: 2024 Sustainability Highlights





Petroleum Terminal in Lebanon: energy consumption from diesel generators at the **Dora Terminal has** decreased by 40%.





Generation: our sites have collectively consumed 2,420 MWh of generated renewable energy compared to 974 MWh in 2023.
