The team from Collège de la Sainte Famille Française – Fanar achieved remarkable success by securing **first place** in the **International VIA Program finals**.

After winning the Lebanese edition of the VIA Program in September 2024, the team from Collège de la Sainte Famille Française – Fanar advanced to the semi-finals on November 26, where they competed against three other countries. Under the supervision of a prestigious jury, the Lebanese students pitched their **road safety recommendations** and proposed **actions** to enhance the **safe mobility** around their school.

Worksite Safety Training





The training emphasized the identification of risks associated with worksites in petroleum warehouses and service stations and focused on the deployment of **risk control measures**.

Speaking of safety




During November 2024, we held our **quarterly meetings** with our **drivers** and **transporters**, reinforcing a culture of safety through **Return of Experience (REX)** exchanges. These regular sessions focus on discussing recent challenges, sharing critical insights, and learning from past incidents to ensure continuous safety during daily operations.

A new life



We donated approximately 700 kilograms of old advertising materials—flex banners and tent covers—to a local supplier specializing in **upcycling**. These materials were transformed into 350 practical and durable bags, saving them from ending up in landfills or being incinerated, thereby avoiding CO₂ emissions.


Towards carbon neutrality

Let's have a look at the **Sharqiyah seawater desalination plant** in the city of Sur, Oman. Operated by Veolia, this plant provides drinking water in a region where water scarcity is a crucial issue. This innovative solution is now partly powered by photovoltaic installations, thanks to **the solar power plant installed by TotalEnergies**.

- For an annual renewable electricity production of 30 GWh
- Thanks to 32,000 photovoltaic panels, the equivalent of around 18 soccer pitches
- Avoiding 16,000 tons /year of CO₂ emissions
